

Student Code of Conduct

All students are asked to commit to and sign this Student Code of Conduct which, if followed, enables a positive and successful educational experience for each individual.

Students are expected to follow the Student Code of Conduct below, at all times, while attending Advance College:

1. No smoking on the premises
2. No spitting
3. No food or drink (with the exception of a resealable bottle) is to be taken into the classrooms
4. Do not bring alcohol, drugs or dangerous items to the program
5. Do not attend the program while under the influence of alcohol or drugs
6. Do not leave the program during participation hours without permission
7. Mobile phones are to be handed in to the teacher during class time
8. No head phones are to be worn in training rooms
9. Students are expected to wear clean neat casual clothes and appropriate footwear (no open toed shoes or thongs)
10. No hats/hoods are to be worn inside the classrooms
11. Do not damage equipment or furniture and respect the property and rights of others
12. Keep the whole program area clean and free of rubbish
13. Respect the rights of all students to learn, to have equal access to teacher time, resources and information
14. Bring a note from parents/guardians to explain absences, late arrivals or a need to leave early
15. Respect cultural, social, intellectual and gender differences without harassment, intimidation or bullying.
16. Do not run or ride bicycles, skateboards or rollerblades inside any of the buildings

In addition to the above, Advance College expects:

1. A consistent demonstration of respect for, teachers, guests, other students, resources and the program environment and self.
2. All instructions are to be followed and all set tasks completed.
3. Excellent attendance and punctuality. A student's place in the program is jeopardised by poor attendance or non-approved absence since, as a small team, we depend upon the active participation of every student, every day.
4. Each student to demonstrate a developing sense of personal responsibility for their words and actions. Foul language will not be tolerated.
5. Failure to comply with the code of conduct may result in the student being required to:
 - attend a disciplinary interview, or
 - re-apply for their place in the program, or
 - exit the program.
